Heard Mr. G. Baishya, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. D. Nath, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam for the respondent Nos. 1 to 5. Also heard Mr. C. Baruah, learned Standing counsel, APSC for the respondent No. 6.

The respondent APSC on 03.08.2019 issued an advertisement for filling up of 73 vacant

posts of Child Development Project Officer (CDPO) and allied Cadres in the Social Welfare Department of the State.

The petitioners are Statistical Assistance in the Department of Social Welfare who are seeking promotion to the post of CDPOs. The apprehension of the petitioners are that the respondents by filling all those 73 posts of CDPOs by way of direct recruitment shall stop the avenues of the promotion to such post from the Statistical Assistants.

Issue notice, returnable by **27.11.2019**.

As Mr. D. Nath, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam and Mr. C. Baruah, learned Standing counsel, APSC accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1 to 5 and 6 respectively, no formal notices need to be issued to those respondents.

Petitioners shall serve requisite extra copies of this writ petition along with the annexures appended thereto to Mr. D. Nath, learned Additional Senior Government Advocate, Assam and Mr. C. Baruah, learned Standing counsel, APSC by 29.10.2019.

The respondents shall not declare the result of selection pursuant to the advertisement dated 03.08.2019 (Annexure VIII to this writ petition) without the leave of the Court.
